An Update from the Return to Worship Committee

Our Return to worship committee is a thoughtful, prayerful group that has spent much time analyzing data, collaborating with other congregations, and working to make the safest possible decisions for our congregation.

As such, we decided in November to step back from in-person worship due to the rising Covid case numbers in our community, the wide community spread, and the numbers of patients in the hospital. As our positive case rate in Cerro Gordo county remains around 20%, we will continue to offer online only worship through the end of the of the year.

This was a very difficult decision during this important, holy season, but one that we felt was necessary. Our building remains open to small meetings, but not to large gatherings. Office hours are Tuesday and Thursday from 9-12. Appointments with the pastors can be made at other times. If you would like to use the building for a meeting, please schedule that with Jill.

We reassess the situation periodically and communicate with you as changes are made.

In the meantime, we have a beautiful Christmas week planned for you, as well as other events planned for you through the month. More information about those events can be found in this Journal, on our website, and on our Facebook page.


CHRISTMAS WEEK
