December 24: Jesus, with the Courage to Follow the Light (3 PM, 5 PM, 10 PM)

May you find joy and peace in the middle of this busy time, and may you always keep in mind the reason we celebrate. Christ has come into the world to set us free, so that we can live with courage and hope.
