<u>LENT 2019</u> "Open My Life, Lord"

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday worship on WEDNESDAY MARCH 6 at 11 AM and 6:30 PM. For the rest of the season of Lent we will be exploring the theme: "Open My Life, Lord."

Far too often, we find ourselves closed off—closed off from our neighbors, closed off from those who love us, closed off from the voice of God. It is difficult to hear one another, to see the truth, to be willing to risk connecting with the world around us. It just seems safer to shut down, close off, and hide. But that is not how God intends us to live. God opens us to new life and new possibilities, new learning and new relationships. And when God opens us up, new things are possible. Join us each week as we explore how God is working in our lives to open us up.
