Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ~1 Corinthians 12:4-7

These words from the Apostle Paul to the Corinthian people were meant to help them see that every person has gifts from the Holy Spirit to use in this world. Every person has a role to play in the Body of Christ. And these words are just as appropriate and important today as they were in the time of Paul.

We may spend a lot of time doing tasks. We may volunteer a lot. We may work to get things done. But how often do we stop and think about our own unique gifts and how to use them to build up the Body of Christ in this place and in the world?

This winter, we will be doing that during our worship time. Our Narrative Lectionary takes us to the Book of Matthew and the early days of Jesus' ministry. As we learn about this and learn about the ways he called people to follow him and help him with his mission, we will ponder the ways he is calling us and what gifts we have to offer. We will reaffirm our baptisms, think about where God is leading us, and look at our Spiritual Gifts and talk about how to use them. We will think about ministries of prayer and healing; teaching and fellowship; mission and service. How can we be a part of the new things God is doing at St. James and out in the world? How can we work together to reach the people of our community? How can we best support each other?

Join us this winter as we talk about these things! And look through this "Journal" to see ways you can start getting involved now.
