"CAN I ASK A QUESTION? Honest questions about faith and God."

Join us for a summer of exploration! Our summer sermon series is "Can I ask a question?" and it is just what it says it is. A summer of asking important questions about the world, faith, and God.

In a world where often the answers aren't clear at all, we may wonder things like: "What is God's role in suffering?" "Why do bad things happen to good people?" "Do miracles still occur?" "What does prayer do?" We might wonder about other world religions, other Christian traditions, or worship practices. We might have questions about big issues the Church and what God's role is in those issues. We might wonder about the Bible and what it means in our life of faith. There are so many questions that come up every day.

So ask them! And we will attempt to address them through sermons and small group discussions. Each Sunday morning during our worship service at 9 AM, we will address one question. We will also have small group discussions various weeks after worship to talk further. AND on Wednesday nights, you are encouraged to join us for HOLDEN EVENING PRAYER at 6:00 PM beginning June 8. Following Evening Prayer each week, we will have a Bible Study/small group focused on a different question.

Since YOU are the ones designing the services, we need YOUR questions. Questions may be left in a basket at the worship service or you may text or email the pastors. That contact information is found on the back page of this "Journal." We hope to hear from a lot of you! And we hope we can all grow in our faith by tackling some important, difficult, and even some fun questions this summer!



have donuts and games following the service that morning. All are welcome!


PICNIC AND CHURCH **SOFTBALL GAME**
