HEALTH UPDATE FROM PASTOR |ENI: Thank you all for your patience and prayers as I have returned to work on a part-time basis. I continue to slowly improve and am working hard at regaining strength and gaining weight! Improvement is of course slower than I would like, but I am grateful that it continues. As I work at getting healthier, I will stay at the very part-time hours I am at right now. As I get stronger, I will increase my hours. I hope to be able to resume my call as full-time pastor sometime this summer.

My responsibilities in my limited hours include worship planning and preaching, teaching, and long-term planning. I attend meetings as I am able. I preside at funerals, baptisms, and weddings as they come up.

Pastor Dennis continues to serve as our visitation pastor on a part-time basis. His hours have decreased as I have returned to work and he travels more often. He will continue to preach occasionally, help lead worship, and visit our homebound and hospitalized members.

We also have a visitation team who visits homebound members and nursing home residents. We are excited to have this group doing this work and excited to

see where this new ministry goes!

If there are other ministry needs that come up that you need assistance with, don't hesitate to contact the office, either Pastor Dennis or myself, or a council member. We will work with you to make sure things continue to be taken care of.

We have a wonderful group of volunteers here at St. James and I am so grateful for all the ways you have stepped up and made sure things continued to run smoothly. I am happy to be stepping back in and look forward to leaping back in soon!
