Return to Indoor Worship and Two Services

Beginning the first Sunday in November, we will move to two services. For the most part, this will follow our pre-Covid schedule. We will have a traditional service at 8 AM and contemporary service with the worship band at 9:30 AM. Adult Bible Study will be held at 9. Children's Sunday School will be held from 10:30-11:15. We will not begin our late service at this time.

The 9:30 service will be live-streamed each Sunday. Due to copyright licenses, we will not be able to broadcast our traditional liturgy right now.

We are excited about a return to a more regular routine! Of course, we will still have some Covid restrictions in place as we continue to navigate through the pandemic. Please understand that this is both for the safety of our members and the consideration of our healthcare workers who have been working tirelessly for so many months to keep us safe.

• Please wear masks in the building, especially for worship and when you are around youth:

Remember that A) many of our young people cannot be vaccinated yet; B) There have been many breakthrough cases recently; and C) Our healthcare workers are overwhelmed.

- We will continue to maintain social distancing in the Sanctuary. The signs for pews will remain up for the time being.
- We will continue with our current offering and communion practices for now.
- The serving of food and drinks will remain in a limited capacity.
- We are currently handing out bulletins and are able to use hymnals. That will continue.
- Choir and Band have resumed rehearsals.
- As always, if you are sick or have been exposed to Covid, we ask you to stay home!

As the health situation changes, we will continue to revisit these guidelines on a regular basis. In the meantime, thank you for your commitment to Jesus' call to love your neighbor as yourself. We appreciate your patience and your commitment to the ministry of St. James!
