Update on our Worship Plans for fall

Dear Congregation,

Our return to worship committee has met and voted to resume indoor worship on Sunday, October 18 at 9 AM.

For now, we will only have ONE indoor, traditional service. We will continue to broadcast online services at 10 AM. The online services will continue to be a blend of worship styles.

To ensure the safety of our congregation, we will require masks or face shields for all in attendance. We will also adhere to physical distancing guidelines. Our pews are marked to ensure distancing.

Due to those guidelines, we will only be able to hold 75 people, including pastors and worship assistants, in the Sanctuary at this time. Therefore, we are asking you to register for services.

Registration can be done by calling the Church office or e-mailing Jill at stjamesofficemc@gmail.com. Please call to register by FRIDAY AT 10 AM. We encourage you to call or email early in the week.

If we find we have more who want to attend than we can hold, we will consider adding additional services. We also strongly encourage you to worship online if you aren't able to attend in person.

We look forward to welcoming you indoors for worship again. Our number one priority will be your safety. Please know that these decisions can change at any time. Registration will ensure that we can contact you if there are any changes in worship for the week. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we prayerfully navigate these decisions!

St. James Care Team

Here at St. James Lutheran Church, we have a Care Team Ministry. One component of this Team is sending boxes of goodies to college students and military personnel away from home. This is a year of unknowns with this Covid Pandemic. We aren't sure what the year will look like. We pray for a wonderful school year and are able to still ship our boxes. We need help with this ministry.

Back in the Spring of 2014, Bob and I had a relative from UNI stay with us for a semester while she completed her student teaching here in Mason City. For Valentine's Day, she received a box of goodies from her home church with a note saying they were thinking of and praying for her. I realized, "Wow! We need to do that at St. James!"

During our first year, we sent out seven boxes three times and last year we increased that number to 18! We also tried something new at Christmas time: Sending a gift card instead of goodies. We've heard great feedback on all of our mailing from recipients. We need your help: Donations of goodies or money to buy the "stuff" and for postage would be greatly appreciated. We spend over \$150.00 for postage each time we ship boxes. We have been lucky to get Thrivent cards to help with the postage, but that's not a guarantee each year. We want these young adults away from home to know that St. James hasn't forgotten them. Prayerfully consider helping with the Care Team Ministry during this current school year.

As you join us for worship, please keep the following guidelines in mind as we work together to stay safe:

- Our expectation is that persons attending must not be experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 as outlined by the CDC.
- All must use proper social distancing practices (6 feet)
- If you have young children, be sure that they remain with the family (arm's length).
- To ensure appropriate distancing coming in and out of the church, please enter through the main door and exit through the door in the Fireside room. For handicap access, please seek out an usher if assistance is needed.
- All in attendance are asked to wear a mask. We will have a small supply for those who may forget. This is to protect you and those who also attend.
- Offering box will be placed in a central location.
- No coffee/donuts provided.
- The service will be displayed on the screens instead of bulletins.
- The red pads will not be distributed.
- The pews in the sanctuary will be roped off to allow for proper distancing.
- Cushions have been removed from the pews.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available to ensure proper hand hygiene at designated stations.
- No singing will be allowed. There will be recorded or special music during the service.
- Ushers will be needed to take count and record names of those in attendance.
- The bathrooms inside the main door will be available.
- Drive through communion will still be available at times separate from the worship service. We are trying to determine how we can make communion work during the indoor service.
- There will still be an online service for those who are not comfortable worshipping in public. This will be available at 10:00 AM.
