PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

If you are new to St. James and not familiar with this ministry or wondering about the awesome display in the narthex, provided by Alf Larson, here its some info for you.

The Prayer Shawl Ministry was started here at St. James in October of 2009, so we are celebrating 10 years! In that time we have given out 337 shawls to church members, family, friends, neighbors, of all ages, here in Mason City or across the country.

The ministry is supported by the congregation in 3 ways:

- 1. Those who receive the shawls are lifted up in prayer (we pray over shawls about once every six weeks or so)
- 2. Together we need many willing hands to knit, crochet and pray over finished shawls (and we have had a few tied-fleece shawls donated by kids)
- 3. Individuals generously donate money or yarn to support the mission (we have yarn available and there are patterns on the display for crocheting and knitting)

So, who can give or receive a shawl? Anyone is encouraged to give a shawl away if the Holy Spirit is leading you to:

Comfort someone who is grieving Encourage a person dealing with a medical condition Help someone struggling with a difficult relationship Celebrate a birth, marriage, or other life event Letting a person know that God loves and cares about him or her

GIVE THEM A SHAWL! IT IS A HUG FROM GOD!

Prayer Shawls are freely made and given in God's love. No one is ever charged for receiving a prayer. Once we get shawls finished, they will be available in the narthex. Just sign the book and record who is receiving the shawl.





Pastor Hehr will talk about his life experiences beginning with his birth in Alt-Posttal, Bessarabia, a German settlement in Russia in 1938. Hear about how his family was expelled and deported to Poland during World War II. This was not the only time his family was forced to move and lost virtually all of their possessions, leading to their eventual immigration to the USA. During his lifetime, Pastor Hehr has shared his story and heard other stories from parishioners, patients, and their families.

Horst Hehr is a retired hospital chaplain and is still active in interim ministries, pulpit supply, and winter ministry in Arizona. He has a Master of Divinity degree and was a Certified Chaplain and Fellow of the College of Chaplains of the American Protestant Hospital Association. He and his wife, Jean, live in Mason City and winter in Arizona.
